

Winter sports top tips 2018/19

Here, FUN is what it's all about!

More than 10 snow trails are spread throughout the ski circus. The combination of moguls, ski jumps, steep curves and narrow forest trails promises any winter guests lots of mountain fun.

Action packed tobogganing

Whether at 'Leo's Kufengaudi' run in Leogang, the natural toboggan run on Biberg in Saalfelden, the illuminated 'Diretissima' natural toboggan run in Fieberbrunn or the toboggan run on Reiterkogel in Saalbach Hinterglemm, the toboggan runs in the Skicircus offer miles of the very best tobogganing fun, even into the late evening!

Alpine rollercoaster

"Full speed ahead!" are words we often hear here during winter at the Streuböden middle station in Fieberbrunn. Timok's Coaster is a speedy two-seater ride that takes you on a 1,160 m rapid downhill ride before comfortably returning you up the hill again with the help of the conveyor belt. Use of Timok's Coaster is included with a valid ski pass!

Zip lining through the valley

The Flying Fox XXL in Leogang is 1,600 m long and reaches a max top speed of 130 km/h, making it one of the longest and fastest steel cable zip lines worldwide. The zip line is up to 143 m high.

Hit the trail!

For cross-country fans, more than 360 km of trails await in the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn area.

Treetop trail with the Golden Gate Bridge of the Alps

At the end of the Saalbach Hinterglemm valley lies the highest treetop trail in Europe. In combination with the 'Golden Gate Bridge of the Alps', this tourist attraction is a truly unique project worldwide.

Step lightly!

The 260 km of winter hiking trails of the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn area offer idyllic winter scenery for walkers and snowshoe hikers alike.

Ice party

On the ice rink at Ritzensee in Saalfelden and at the Saalbach Hinterglemm sports centre, ice princesses and snow kings can practise their pirouettes.

Trotting through the snow

Wrapped in warm blankets, guests glide on horse-drawn sleighs through the winter wonderlands and snow-covered forests of Saalbach Hinterglemm, Saalfelden Leogang and Fieberbrunn.

Hit the bull's eye

Have a go at winter archery in Saalbach Hinterglemm and Saalfelden Leogang and take a shot at up to 28 different targets with varying levels of difficulty.

Nordic Park Saalfelden Leogang

The Nordic Park at Ritzensee provides the essence of winter sport expertise - but off-piste! In the popular Fun & Snow Park, little ones can already have a go at learning the basics of cross-country skiing, while skaters can enjoy having the picturesque Ritzensee and Steinernes Meer as the backdrop for their pirouettes. Cross-country skiers can glide past the glittering snowy landscapes of the region on a trail network covering approximately 150 km, with varying degrees of difficulty. Or how about a snowshoe hike or toboggan ride? All this and much more is possible at the Nordic Park!
